

Admissions Policy

Introduction

As a community and controlled school, Derbyshire County Council is the admission authority for the school.

Admission arrangements for the 2018 intake were determined 13.02.18, and DCC are now consulting on the 2018/19 arrangements

The planned admission level for the 7+ age group in 2018/2019 is 60. Attendance at Brockwell Infants gives no priority for admission to Brockwell Juniors. Places need to be applied for.

Full details of the admission procedure, and the criteria used, is contained in Derbyshire County Council's booklet entitled "How to apply for a place at Primary School - A guide for parents". To ensure that children make a positive start at Brockwell Junior School, we have several opportunities for them to visit the school. All children due to start at Brockwell Junior School will have the opportunity to visit several times following our transition timetable during June and July. Parents moving into the area may bring their child in at any time.

A meeting for new parents is held during June or July when they are able to see the school, meet the staff and discuss any matters of interest. Those parents unable to attend, or whose child is starting at a later date, may contact the school when the headteacher will be pleased to show them around the school at a convenient time.

Each year, Brockwell Junior School has to admit eligible pupils on request up to our published admissions number.

In the event that school is oversubscribed a waiting list is held by Derbyshire County Council and places are released if and when a child leaves school in that year group.

In Year admissions are dealt with by DCC

The maximum class size for our other junior classes is 34 pupils but may be changed by the Governors if the need arises.

At the present time pupils will only be considered for admission to classes in other year groups where there are less than 34 pupils on roll.

In allocating places to Brockwell, we follow the guidelines of the Local Authority. Their criteria are intended to ensure that those children in greatest need have access to junior places. Please see the link above.

Before any child is admitted to school, it is important that parents and previous providers have informed us of anything vital to meeting the child's needs. All children admitted to Brockwell Junior School should ideally visit before being admitted and this provides an opportunity for knowledge to be passed on. In addition, records are sought from previous primary education providers.

Parents are expected to complete and return registration papers including a registration form, pupil permission form, IT permission agreement, pink card and home school agreement prior to close of school in the term before the child starts school.
