Objectives include:

Literacy objectives include:

- To analyse the structure of a story.
- To understand that stories can start in different ways.
- To introduce a new character to a story
- To understand features in a poem and to prepare a poem to perform. To think about the shape and meaning of concrete poems.
- To write for different audiences; a postcard sent from aboard the Titanic, a recount of the fatal voyage (assessed writing).

Numeracy objectives include:

- Use, read and write standard metric units of length and weight.
- Recognize reflective symmetry and axis of symmetry.
- Names and properties of 3D shapes.
- Number bonds to 100.
- Derive doubles and halves of numbers up to 10,000.
- Changing improper fractions to mixed numbers.
- Recognizing equivalent simple fractions.
