This term's autumn topic for year 6 is: Time Machine

Numeracy: Understanding the value of numbers including tenths and hundredths. Ordering & rounding numbers. Multiplying and dividing decimals mentally by 10 and 100. Doubling and halving. Rapid recall of X facts.

Fractions, Percentages and Decimals—relationships between.

Properties of 2D shape. Solving word problems concerning concepts above.

Writing: Biography and autobiography. Short stories with flashbacks. Journalistic writing. Diary writing. Clauses and complex sentences and the use of connectives.

Reading: To become independent readers and further develop comprehension skills.

Topic: Victorian Britain: A study of the impact of significant individuals, events and changes in work and transport on the lives of men, women and children from different sections of society. A study of the key features, including the everyday lives of men, women and children, of a past society: eg Greece or other.

PE: Dance—Netball—Gym

Art: Olympic Regatta pictures in the style of Raoul Dufy. Topic art including Queen Victoria portraits and charcoal pictures capturing the Industrial Revolution.

RE: The life of a Jewish child in World War II. Celebrations - Christmas, Harvest

French: Sport and healthy eating

ICT: Instructive text for use of the internet. Designing and making a digital museum box.

Science & Technology: Life Processes and Living Things
