- To identify and describe 3D shapes.
- To read the time on analogue and digital clocks.
- To round numbers less than 100 to the nearest 10.
- To add and subtract a 2-digit number to and from a 2- or 3-digit number.
- To measure and compare capacities in litres and millilitres.
- To know doubles of numbers to 20 and corresponding halves.
