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### **INFORMATION REGARDING HOLIDAYS DURING TERM TIME**

In September 2013, the Education (Pupil Registration) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 came into force. These regulations make it clear that Headteachers should not grant approval for any leave of absence during term-time, including holidays, unless there are exceptional circumstances. These regulations also state that holidays cannot be authorised retrospectively. Any requests should be on an official school absence request form (on our website or in the office) and handed into the school office for consideration prior to any holiday/leave arrangements being made and in any event at least 14 days before the requested dates. You may be issued with a Penalty Notice should leave be taken which is not authorised. If unpaid this could lead to prosecution under section 444(1) of The Education Act 1996. Where a child is absent with no reason provided and the Headteacher has grounds to believe that the child is on holiday, then the absence will be challenged and a penalty notice may be issued.
