If you do not give permission, we'll ensure that your child is included in the in-school aspects but not film them. Please complete the permission slip attached which is specifically for this event. We will not change your general permissions unless you ask us to.

I'll send a slip home soon regarding costumes once teachers are clear about how they would like their scene to be developed and after casting. We will aim to engage children who would like to take key parts and if we have more than the number required we will hold short auditions within the bubble.
