Governing bodies are accountable to parents, the local community and the LA (Derbyshire County Council) – they are at the heart of how a school operates and how they undertake their role effects the interests of pupils, staff, and the reputation of the school in the community.

Governors help to set our school's vision, ethos, and strategy; they hold the Headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils, and oversee the school's financial performance to make sure the money is spent wisely and achieves best value. The school appreciates the wide range of skills, knowledge and experience Governors bring to the school; the support and advice they provide is invaluable.

We record Governor attendance at Board of Governors meetings and its committees. However, this does not provide a complete picture of Governor involvement. As well as playing their part at the meetings, they also visit and get to know the school, support staff with specific projects and attend school events. Many Governors also work or have other busy roles – so we value the time they can give us.

- Each committee requires a minimum of three Governors to be in attendance to meet the quorum.
- Regarding the Board meetings, a minimum of 50% of Governors are required to be in attendance to meet the quorum.
